

Activism at Abortion Clinics

The Women's Resource Medical Center of Southern Nevada employees and volunteers are expected to project an image and attitude of compassion and empathy toward clients. The Women's Resource Medical Centers of Southern Nevada believes that the ability to do this may be jeopardized if its employees or volunteers are observed by clients or others participating in protest activities at or near abortion clinics. Therefore, all center employees and volunteers are expected to refrain from engaging in any such abortion clinic activism whether during work hours or during off-hours. This includes picketing, sidewalk counseling, and acts of civil disobedience. This policy does not limit staff from participating in other political activities during their own time, including participation in peaceful pro-life marches.
