Public Disclosure of Corporate Documents

The Women's Resource Medical Centers of Southern Nevada's Form 1023 (Application for Tax-Exempt Status) and Forms 990 (Informational Tax Returns) must be made available for public inspection and copying upon request.

The Form 1023 application to the IRS and Form 990 for the previous three years shall be available for inspection by the public during normal office hours. The names and addresses of contributors of Schedule B shall be redacted in the form that is made available to the public. If someone from the public requests a copy of the Form 990, they shall be referred to www.guidestar.com where the Center's Treasurer has confirmed it to be widely distributed. Otherwise, copies will be provided for a fee of \$1.00 per page plus postage, if any. Other corporate documents, such as bylaws, minutes, financials and policies and procedures shall be maintained as internal documents and shall not be made available to the general public, unless for a business reason as determined by the Chief Executive Officer and approved by the Board of Trustees.
